Statement by the Honorable Gary G. Miller (R-CA) Chairman of the House Financial Services Subcommittee on International Monetary Policy and Trade

WASHINGTON, DC – This evening, President Obama delivered his State of the Union address. In response, Congressman Gary G. Miller released the following statement:
