Statement by Congressman Gary Miller on President Obama's Budget Proposal

WASHINGTON, DC –Congressman Gary Miller issued the following statement following the release of President Obama's proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2012:

“Every day, hardworking Americans must make difficult choices to provide for their families while living within their means. Unfortunately, their government has failed to do the same.

Today, the President released his budget proposal for Fiscal Year 2012 which will lead to a larger federal government, higher taxes on our nation's job creators, and a crushing national debt that will be passed on to future generations of Americans. Despite the fact that the proposed budget itself forecasts an unsustainable \$1.6 trillion budget deficit for the current fiscal year – larger than previously estimated – the President's budget will result in \$8.7 trillion in new spending over the next decade. To pay for this reckless spending spree, the budget imposes job-crushing tax increases on businesses that will hinder our economy's ability to recover and create new jobs.

To grow this economy, we cannot continue to spend money we do not have and tax and regulate our nation's employers out of business. I hope the President will work with House Republicans to seriously address the economic challenges facing our nation.”
