Rep. Gary Miller Demands Los Angeles County Repay Federal Assistance

WASHINGTON, DC – Yesterday, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors voted 3 to 2 to boycott Arizona in response to the passage of its illegal immigration law. Following the County's decision to boycott, Congressman Gary Miller released the following statement:

“Los Angeles County's move to boycott Arizona is outright hypocritical. Los Angeles County is a participant in the 287(g) program and begs for increased reimbursement for State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP). LA County cannot talk out of both sides of their mouth by voting to boycott Arizona while at the same time accepting millions of dollars in federal reimbursement for jailing illegals and working with DHS to check the immigration status of aliens that have been detained.

“LA County officials were in Washington, DC a few weeks ago begging for increased SCAAP reimbursement. They should put their money where their mouth is and reimburse the millions of dollars that they received from the federal government last year for jailing illegals. I am sure Orange and San Bernardino Counties would welcome the extra assistance. I commend Supervisors Knabe and Antonovich for casting the correct vote, they are the right side of this issue and they should be applauded.”
